

5 Ways to Send Money to the Philippines

REGISTRATION to PNB Remittance Facility

1. Duly fill up the Remittance Membership Registration Form (RMR)
2. Submit in person or by mail, the duly filled up RMR (both sides), a clear copy of an acceptable valid ID and **My Number**.

If you wish to register and remit at the same time, you may either visit in person or use a Money Envelope "Genkin Kakitome."

POSTAL LINK



After registration to PNB Remittance and to Postal Link Remittance Facility, proceed with the step below:

STEP 1

Go to any Japan Post Bank with a Postal Link Card. Transfer funds thru ATM or over the counter. No need for Remittance Instruction.

Main Features of POSTAL LINK

- ❑ **Fast** Same day credit after 3 pm for fund transfers made from 8 am to 11:30 am (Mondays thru Fridays).
- ❑ **Next Banking Day Credit** For fund transfers made after 11:30 am to 7 pm or at the latest hour of 9 pm, Saturdays after the 11:30 cut-off & holidays.
- ❑ **Sunday Processing** For fund transfers made after 11:30am to 9pm on Fridays and from 8am to 11:30am on Saturdays.
- ❑ **Easy to use** at Japan Post Bank ATMs all over Japan.
- ❑ **Convenient**
 - ❖ No remittance instruction is needed once registered to Postal Link. One Postal Link Card for one Beneficiary. Postal Link Card is free for the first 5 Beneficiaries.
 - ❖ One PNB remittance charge for combining multiple yen funds transferred before Cut-off time or after Cut-off time for remittance more than 100,000 yen to the same beneficiary.
 - ❖ For JPY1M and above remittances, supporting documents shall be required.
- ❑ **Cheaper**. Domestic transfer charge at Japan Post Bank is cheap. (Charges are subject to change)
- ❑ For Philippine bound remittances, applicable to GFC, PNB Online Accounts (PNB Savings and Checking Accounts) and Advise & Pay (pay over the counter in Philippine Peso only)
- ❑ **Lower** PNB remittance charge.

VIRTUAL ACCESS

After registration to PNB Remittance and to Virtual Access Remittance Facility, proceed with the step below:

STEP 1

Go to any Japanese banks' ATM or Japan Post Bank's ATM or over the counter and transfer funds using the Virtual Account Number issued to you. No need for Remittance Instruction.

Main Features of VIRTUAL ACCESS

- ❑ **Fast**. Same day credit to PNB Accounts in the Philippines if fund transfer is made before 3 pm.
- ❑ **Easy to use** at any Japanese banks' ATMs or over-the-counter.
- ❑ **Convenient**. No remittance instruction is needed once registered to Virtual Access. One Virtual Account Number for one Beneficiary. Virtual Access Account Number is free for the first 5 Beneficiaries.
 - ❖ For JPY1M and above remittances, supporting documents shall be required.
- ❑ For Philippine bound remittances, applicable to GFC and PNB Online Accounts ONLY (PNB Savings and Checking Accounts).
- ❑ **Lower** PNB remittance charge.

Bank Transfer "Ginko Furikomi"

After registration to PNB Remittance Facility, proceed with the steps below:

STEP 1

Go to any Japanese bank, Japan Post Bank or Convenience Store and transfer funds EITHER to:

STEP 2

Call, Email, Fax or Text your remittance instruction to PNB Tokyo or Nagoya where you registered and transferred your funds.



Remittance will be processed on the same day if fund transfers and instructions are received before 3 pm.

Post Office "Genkin Kakitome"

STEP 1

Enclose in the Money Envelope "Genkin Kakitome":

- Money
- Duly filled up Remittance Membership Registration and/or Application for Remittance (RMR)
- Clear copy of acceptable valid ID



STEP 2

Mail

PNB Tokyo Branch or Nagoya Sub Branch will receive your Genkin Kakitome in 1-2 working days and remittance will be processed on the day the Postal Money Envelope is received.

Over-the-counter (Walk-In)

An acceptable valid ID (Original ID) is required.

Access trains to PNB Tokyo

- Toei Asakusa / Mita Line
 - 浅草線 ● 三田線 to **Mita Station**, Exit A1, 5 min walk
- JR Yamanote / JR Keihin-Tohoku Line
 - 山手線 ● 京浜東北 to **Tamachi Station**, Mita Exit (West Exit), 7 min walk

Access trains to PNB Nagoya

- Subway Higashiyama Line
 - 東山線 to **Sakae Station** (West Wicket then Exit 8, 5 min walk)
- Subway Meijo Line
 - 名城線 to **Sakae Station** (To Higashiyama Platform, West Wicket then Exit 8, 8 min walk)
