
Pop-Up Blocker Settings and Enabling Auto-Updates

A. GOOGLE CHROME BROWSER

1. Auto-Update Setting

When updates are available in Google Chrome, the updates normally happen automatically in the background when you close and reopen your computer's browser.

- 2. Set-up Popup Blocker Exception
 - a. Open Chrome Browser
 - b. Click on the 3 vertical dots on the upper-right corner of the window




c. Click "Settings"



d. Type "pop" on the search settings box to display "Privacy" settings.




e. Click on "Content settings" Button



f. Under "Content settings", look for "Pop -ups" then click the "Manage Exceptions" button.



g. From "pop up exception" screen, input cms.pnb.com.ph on the hostname pattern box then select "allow" under Behavior, then click "done" to exit.



- h. Click "Done" again the Content Setting screen to save the changes.
- i. Restart "Google Chrome" to effect the changes.
